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BIG IDEA

Flourishing happens when we courageously step into God's Kingdom call.

KEY SCRIPTURES

Joshua 1:1-9, Matthew 14:22-33, Philippians 1:6

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1. What stood out to you most from Joshua 1:1-9 or this week's message?
 2. Joshua was stepping into an entirely new season after Moses. Why do seasons of change often bring fear, uncertainty, or hesitation?
 3. God repeatedly tells Joshua to "be strong and courageous." What does that reveal about the kind of season God was calling Joshua into?
 4. The sermon talked about choosing Kingdom calling over control. Why is control often difficult to surrender during uncertain seasons?
 5. Have you ever sensed God leading you into a new season that stretched your faith or pulled you out of your comfort zone? How did you respond?
 6. God reminds Joshua that He will be with him wherever he goes. How does God's presence help us flourish even in difficult seasons?
 7. Joshua 1:7-8 emphasizes staying rooted in God's Word. How does Scripture bring clarity for your Kingdom calling during confusing or overwhelming seasons?
 8. The sermon said "Flourishing begins where comfort ends." What do you think flourishing actually looks like in a real season of challenge, uncertainty, or obedience?
 9. Is there an area of your life right now where God may be calling you to step forward in faith, trust Him more deeply, or release control so you can flourish in your Kingdom calling?
 10. What is one practical step of courage, obedience, or trust you can take this week as you step into the season God is calling you toward?
