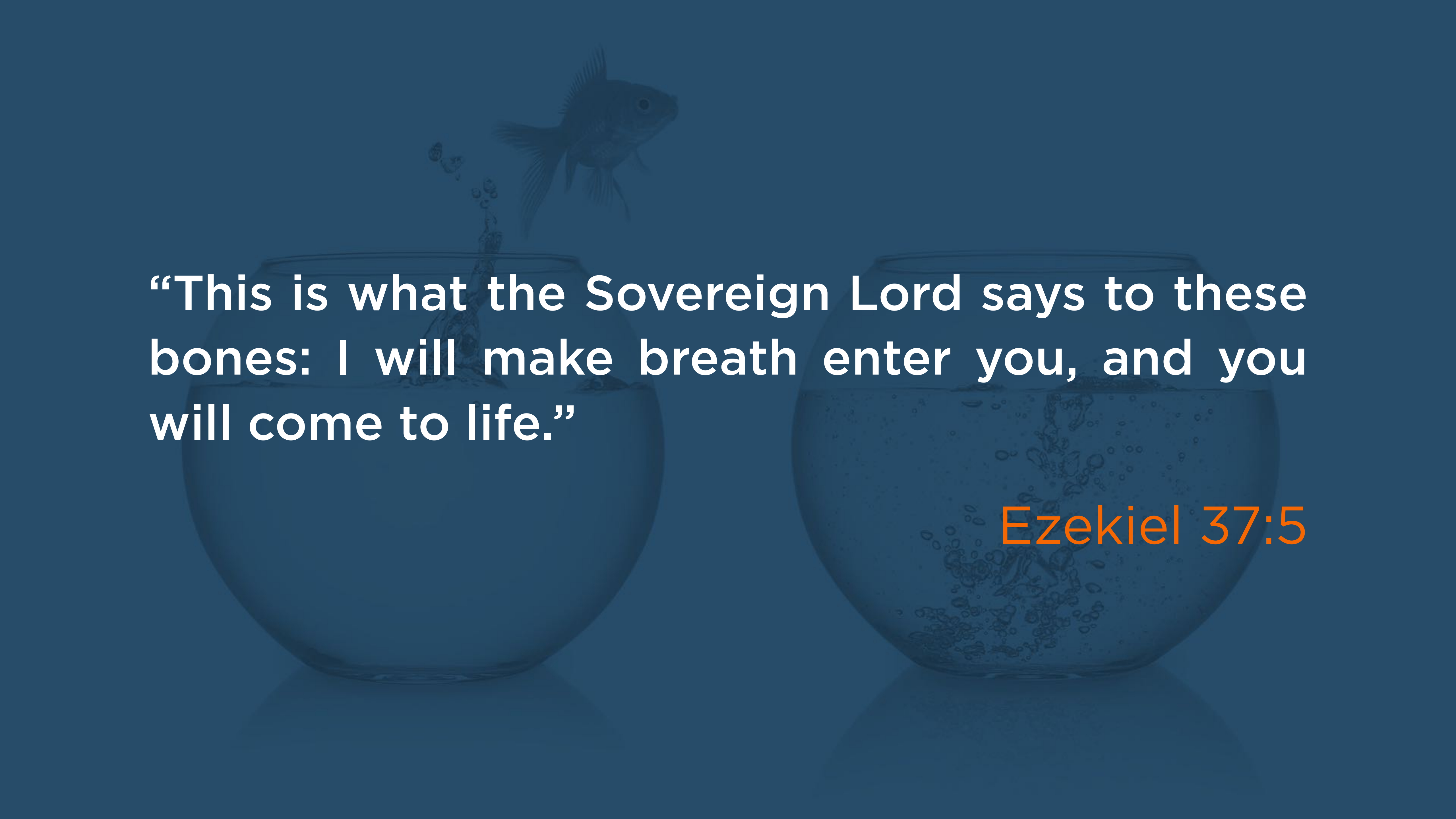
FIRSTFRUITS

One day festival

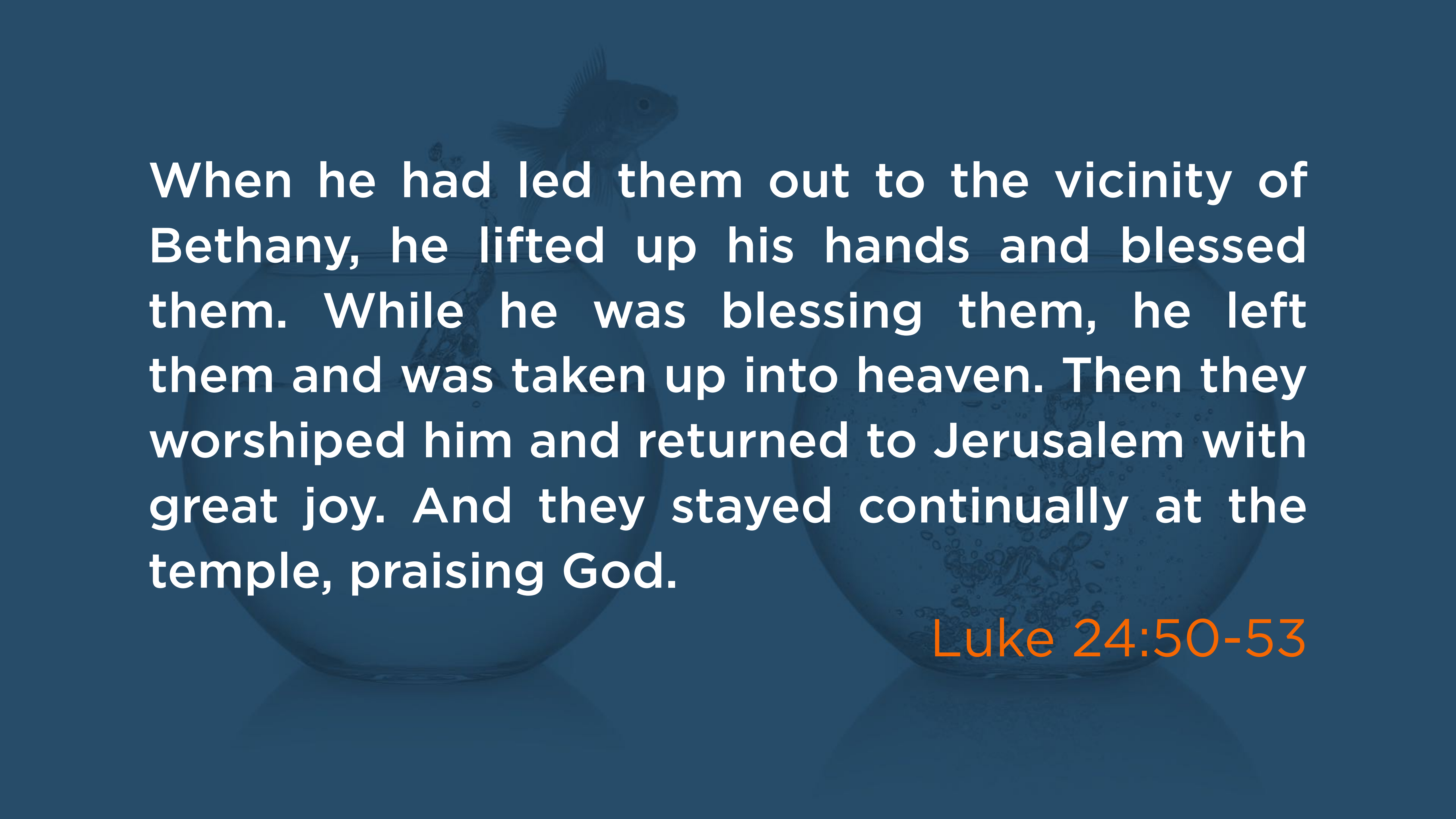
Concluded the barley harvest and anticipated
