DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What was your major takeaway from the message this morning?
2. It is possible to under-estimate what can be achieved with God over time. Looking back, can you think of a moment where God took you further than you could have imagined or helped you achieve more than you thought you could?
3. Describe an influential person in your life who believed in you and was willing to wait with and for you? What did they do that was so significant to you? How has your life been blessed as a result?
4. Describe a commitment you made that was hard to keep. What made you commit in the first place and what made it so hard to honor that commitment? From that experience, what difference does honoring a commitment make? Is it ever right not to honor a commitment?
5. Embracing an 'end of the beginning' mentality invites the Christian to live with the right attitude - God is with us - and in the right place - I'm where I need to be. Are you in the right place with God and with others?
6. Can you think of a time when you weren't in the right place? What did you do to get right?
