WORD

Read Matthew 3:2; Mark 1:15; Zechariah 2:10-11

1. What do these passages teach me about people?
2. What do these passages teach me about God?

MESSAGE

Think back to the message. Choose 2 or 3 of the following:

1. Have you come to believe in a Jesus that saves your soul but is not ruler of your life?
2. Why do you think Jesus died?
3. Why do you think Jesus lived?
4. Mt. 3:2 - "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." What do you think "repent" means? What do you think it means for the kingdom of heaven to have come near?
5. Jesus lived for a purpose; your life has a purpose too. Spend some time studying/discussing the purpose of Jesus' life in order to find the purpose of your own.
