WORD - Mt. 11:2-12; Micah 2:12-13; Mt. 13:31-32

1. What do you learn from these scriptures?
2. How will you pray differently in light of these Scripture? What new perspective do you receive?
How will this cause you to live differently?

MESSAGE

1. Identify your "empire" - your sphere of influence - Who do you influence? Whose lives are impacted by yours? What kind of impact is it?
2. Mt. 11:2-3 shows us John the Baptist questioning Jesus' deeds. When have you questioned what Jesus is or isn't doing?
3. Is there something in your life currently that God is not handling in the way you want? Go to Him in prayer and let Him know, then trust that He knows what is best.
4. "God often advances the kingdom through the small and seemingly insignificant." Identify a time in your life when this happened.
5. Mt. 13:31-32 - Identify "mustard seeds" you think may be growing in your life right now. Share with God how you would like to see them grow, then trust Him for the outcome.
