1. What was your major takeaway?
2. Lesson #1: "Past mistakes don't prevent God from using us for His purposes." When have you seen God accomplish His purposes through a mess you created? What did you learn? How has that lesson changed the way you live now?
3. "Failure is only temporary if you keep on trying." Scale (1-7): How well do you handle failure? How has this message caused you to think differently about failure?
4. "God is a God of second chances." Reflect: Where would you be today if God was not a God of second chances? How does God's mercy cause you to live differently?
5. How has God revealed Himself through a personal weakness in your life? What was God able to accomplish through this experience?
6. In light of Jonah's story, How would you encourage someone who is struggling with their own weakness?
7. How has a past failure held you back? What will you commit to do as a result of this message?
8. Where do you feel God is calling you to follow Him?
9. Where are you right now? a.) On the giving end of ministry or b.) On the receiving end of ministry? How is God speaking to you in this unique position?
10. "God uses us while we're growing, before we've arrived!" How does this Truth cause you to think differently about ministry?
