1. What did you learn from this scripture today?
2. What did God teach you about yourself from this passage?
3. What did God teach you about Himself from this passage?
4. What impact should this scripture have on your life?

MESSAGE

1. What was your main takeaway from this teaching?
2. Brad told us of Moses asking God His name in Exodus 3 - what do you ask God to reveal to you about Himself?
3. Camping at Etham, the Israelites are faced with leaving the known to enter the unknown. Has there been a point in your life you were faced with the same? How did it grow you?
4. The Israelites came to a point where it seemed to be easier to remain slaves in Egypt than to trust God in the unknown. Have you ever been there? What were the circumstances?
5. Passing through the sea on dry ground, the Israelites got to see God show up in a most miraculous way. How has God shown up in unmistakable ways in your life? What has He taught you in those times?
6. Forty years in the desert became Israel's norm, their "known." Has the desert become your "known" right now? If so, what is God teaching you in it?

RESPONSE

1. What are you reasonably sure God is telling you to do in response to this teaching?
2. Think and pray of what commitment God is calling you to make for the Stronger Campaign.
