WORD - Jonah 3:9 - 4:11

1. What did you learn from this passage of scripture?
2. If this is a familiar story to you, what new thing have you learned from today's teaching?

MESSAGE

1. Are there people or groups of people that you feel should not receive God's forgiveness and mercy? Why? What makes them different from you?
2. Read 4:1-2 again. How do you typically respond when things don't go your way?
3. Read 4:6 again. What object lessons has God used to draw you out of rebellion?
4. Read 4:11 again. Think of a time that you have chosen to show compassion instead of justice. What was the response of those involved?
5. Read 4:11 again. Think of a time when you meted out justice instead of compassion. What was the response of those involved?
6. Jonah shows us through the Ninevites that God truly wants everyone to repent and turn to Him. That includes you. Is there anything in your life that is keeping you from turning to God?

RESPONSE

1. What are you reasonably sure God wants you to do in response to this message?
2. What steps can you take this week to begin making that happen?
3. What have been your main takeaways from this series on Jonah?
