Key Scripture:

Mark 5:1-8

Mark 5:18-20

1. Wes said that truth without grace is mean, but grace without truth is meaningless. Think back on when someone spoke truth to you but didn't stop to consider grace when presenting truth. How did you respond to the truth you were told?
2. "What if spiritual maturity wasn't defined by how many believers you know, but by how many unbelievers you serve?" Discuss as a group.
3. Consider the first two steps Wes mentioned: LIST & PRAY
 - a. God has uniquely given you eyes to see the people in your life. Take time to think about who those unique people are...what unique experiences has God given you that give you eyes to see and know them?
 - b. List some people you can start praying for.
 - c. Prayer motivates action. Spend some time in prayer as a group. Pray for the people in your life that God has given you eyes for.
4. Wes said that when we don't invest before we invite we reinforce the stereotype that God doesn't want something for, but something from you. Have you found this to be true when you have invited someone to church? What has been your experience with investing and inviting?
5. This week as you consider these next steps, think of 1-2 people who can be added to your list to starting praying for. We are only a couple weeks away from our outdoor 4th of July celebration! Who are some people that you have already invested in that you can extend the invite to?
