1. John 1:14 tells us that God came to dwell with us. Why do you believe the creator of the universe desires to dwell in us?
2. According to Psalm 91, what are the benefits of dwelling in Christ. Have you found your home in Christ? If so, what does that look like for you on a daily basis?
3. 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 & 6:19 reminds us that we are the temple of the Holy Spirit. Have you allowed Christ to "make Himself at home" in you? Why or why not?
5. Do you believe you have to clean up your "house" for Him to come in?
6. Paul prays for believers in Ephesians 3: 14-21 that Christ's would dwell in our hearts through faith. Have you given Christ the keys to all the rooms in your heart?
7. Is there any "room" you are trying to keep locked? Can you name that room? Will you give Christ the keys?
8. What do you and I have in common with John the Baptist in the John 1? Do you know you are a witness to the light? Who are you helping find their way home?
9. What is your New Year's Resolution? What would change in your heart, family, neighborhood, church...if your 1st resolution was to allow Christ to "make Himself at home in every room of your heart?"
